We hope to submit the planning application for the Lochluichart East BESS proposal to The Highland Council in the early summer of 2025.

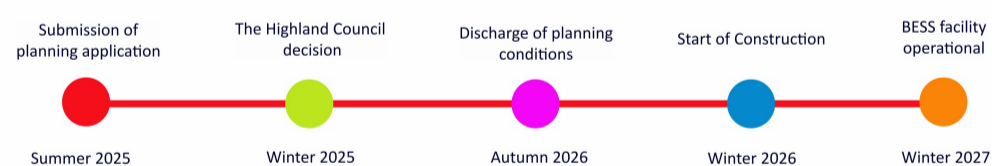
Once the planning application submitted, professional bodies in the fields of ecology, noise, landscape, cultural heritage, transport etc. will be formally consulted.
